CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM.

ROLL CALL:

Present were Secretary Amie Espinosa-Gonzalez, Vice-Chairman Sam Spann and Chairman Donald Schiffbauer. Also present were Assistant Law Director Toni Morgan and Deputy Clerk of Council Tina Wieber.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Regular Meeting Minutes of March 25, 2024

Chairman Schiffbauer asked if the Commission had any questions or revisions regarding the regular meeting minutes of March 25, 2024.

None were given.

Moved by Schiffbauer and seconded by Spann to approve the regular meeting minutes March 25, 2024.

A voice vote was taken and the motion carried.

REPORTS:

Status update for Police & Fire Entrance Examinations

Deputy Clerk of Council Wieber discussed the number of candidates that had applied for both the Police and Fire examinations and scheduled to take the examination. She added that the application period would end on May 27th. She talked about the advertising sites and newspapers that the postings were listed in as well.

Chairman Schiffbauer commented that he hoped the number continued to grow prior to May 27th.

Chairman Schiffbauer stated that the Commission had received the Oath of Office for Patrolman Kevin Barber dated Friday, April 19, 2024, and congratulated him and his family.

Re-certify the Police Patrolman Class D Entrance Eligibility list due to patrolman appointment.

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Chairman Schiffbauer stated that the Commission had received a copy of that list and that due to the appointment of the patrolman, the Commission would need to re-certify the Police Patrolman Class D Entrance Eligibility list.

Moved by Schiffbauer and seconded by Espinosa-Gonzalez to approve the Police Patrolman Class D Entrance Eligibility list.

A voice vote was taken and the motion carried.

Certification of payroll by Civil Service Commission (Per Rule I, Section 3).

Chairman Schiffbauer stated that due to the appointment of Patrolman Kevin Barber, the Commission would need to certify payroll. He discussed that the Commission had a chance to review the list and asked if there were any questions.

None were given.

Moved by Schiffbauer and seconded by Spann to certify payroll list.

A voice vote was taken and the motion carried.

Yes – 3 No – 0

Police Sergeant Promotional Examination candidate participation.

Chairman Schiffbauer explained to Vice-Chairman Spann that if he had read the minutes, he saw that they had a candidate that did not submit the necessary documentation prior to the deadline date and at that time, the Administration decided that they would leave it up to the Civil Service Commission to make the decision on whether or not the applicant was eligible to take the exam. He asked Deputy Clerk of Council Wieber if he was correct that she had not received confirmation that the candidate wanted to take the exam prior to the March 1st deadline.

Deputy Clerk of Council Wieber stated that that was correct.

Chairman Schiffbauer explained that at the last meeting they had taken a vote, which was one ye and one nay, so they decided to table it to the current meeting. He stated that the Commission had received information regarding Rule I, Administration, from the Civil Service Rules. He then read the rule. He explained that the Commission also had before them a copy of the communication that was sent to all participants for the testing process dated February 2nd. He discussed that on the form in all caps, it stated, "Please notify this office no later than 4 PM, Friday, March 1, 2024, of your acceptance or rejection to participate in the examination process, using the enclosed form. A response must be received and failure to respond will be considered a negative reply". He then talked about the next page being the promotional examination response form, which required a response due by 4 PM, Friday, March 1, 2024, and that the applicant could either accept or decline. He added that again, in Rule 5, of the Civil Service Rules, the last sentence stated, "Failure to respond to the notice, will be considered a negative reply". He then asked if there was any discussion from the Commission.

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Vice-Chairman Spann asked if they were split on their vote.

Chairman Schiffbauer explained that they were at that meeting, but after having had the rules before him, and the clear notification that was provided to all recipients that were potentially taking the test, he thought they should uphold the ineligibility because the officer did not submit the enclosed form in the given timeframe.

Moved by Schiffbauer and seconded by Spann to uphold the ineligibility due to the officer not submitting the response form during the required timeframe.

A voice vote was taken and the motion carried.

Rule VIII, Appointments of Police and Fire Personnel, Section 1, Number of names to be certified; appointment from other appropriate lists.

Chairman Schiffbauer stated that there was an amendment presented at the previous meeting regarding Rule VIII, Section 1, and read the second paragraph's current language. He then read the proposed language to be added after the second paragraph.

Moved by Schiffbauer and seconded by Espinosa-Gonzalez to approve the amendment to Rule VIII, Section 1, added language.

A voice vote was taken and the motion carried.

Review of protests to the Police Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain Promotional written exams.

Lieutenant's Examination, Question No. 47

Chairman Schiffbauer read the examination question along with the correct answer. He then read the protest and the testing company's response. He asked Police Chief Freeman if the question was applicable to the position of Lieutenant.

Chief Freeman stated that it was not.

Chairman Schiffbauer asked if there were any questions from the Commission members.

None were given.

Moved by Schiffbauer and seconded by Spann to grant the protest and remove the question from the Lieutenant's promotional examination.

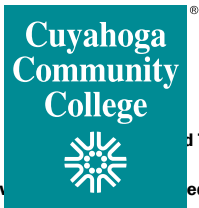

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Police Physical Agility Testing

Assessments

The Police Physical Agility Program conducts three assessments for numerous area law enforcement agencies:

- Police Physical Agility Exam (\$70 fee)
- Written Cognitive Assessment (\$60 fee)
- Pre-Screening Psychological Assessment (\$60 fee)

Police Officer Physical Agility Exam:

Cuyahoga Community College will issue a certificate of completion to participant's who successfully pass the Police Physical Agility Exam at the 15th percentile* of the Cooper Standards. It is the participant's responsibility to provide the agency or agencies he/she is testing for with a copy of their certificate of completion. The certificate will be valid for one year, unless otherwise stated by the agency the candidate is testing for.

Participants should dress appropriately (no sleeveless shirts, extremely baggy shorts/pants, and/or short shorts). The 1.5-mile run will be conducted on an outdoor track unless weather conditions do not permit.

** Effective Jan. 12, 2024 standards have changed from the 30th percentile.*

Written Cognitive Assessment:

This Assessment is provided for participating law enforcement departments. The assessment battery has been created by independent experts, validated by scientific research and will be administered impartially and fairly.

Pre-Screening Psychological Assessment:

This Assessment is provided for participating law enforcement departments. The assessment battery has been created by independent experts, validated by scientific research and will be administered impartially and fairly.

Prerequisites

- Must be in excellent physical condition.*
- Must register and pay the testing fee by the Wednesday prior to the test date, providing a valid email address so you can receive your specific start time and other important information.
- Must read, complete and return the participant packet to the academy staff the day of the assessment. (This is emailed to you in the above mentioned email).
- Must show actual photo ID to be permitted into the testing area.

*It is highly recommended that participants consult with their personal physician before taking the physical agility exam.

Please note: Cuyahoga Community College does not assume any responsibility for any medical consequences that might arise from participating in the Police Officer Physical Agility Exam.

Registration Information

All Police Physical Agility Exams are held on Sundays and last **approximately 2 hours**. Participants must be in the classroom for orientation promptly at their scheduled time or they will not be able to take the exam that day.

Test dates and registration are online. The registration deadline is 4 p.m. the Wednesday prior to the test date.

You will register and pay for a specific date. Prior to the start day you will receive an email from our staff with an assigned time for your test. **No walk-ins.**

Certificates will be emailed to the participants within three (3) business days.

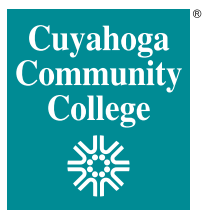
