Chairman Rothgery asked the representative to give a brief overview of his project.

Tom Aubry explained that they are basically going to place a cabinet about five to ten feet away from the existing traffic control box located on that corner. This cabinet will receive their fiber optic line which will be coming up Cook and sitting on that pole, going into the cabinet and from there it goes out onto another fiber line which will provide internet, cable and phone service to all the residents.

Chairman Rothgery asked how big the cabinet will be.

Tom Aubry stated approximately three foot by three foot. He stated that the exact dimensions are shown on the plans.

Chairman Rothgery stated that the rough estimate was fine. He opened the floor for questions

and comments from the Commission. Hearing none, he opened the floor for additional comments or questions from the Administration. Hearing none, he opened the floor for comments or questions from the audience. Hearing none, he addressed the Commission and requested a motion.

It was moved by Anderson and seconded by Swallow to approve the installation of a cable provider optical hub cabinet.

Motion was approved by a vote of five yes and zero no.

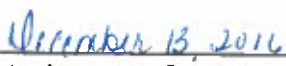
ADJOURNMENT:
