ADMINISTRATORS REPORTS:

A. Mayor:

Mayor Gillock: Thank you, Mr. President. I'll keep it very short this evening after returning from a few days off and trying to get caught up. I want to first welcome Pack 100 for being here tonight and thank you for leading us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The only other thing I want to mention is Halloween, this year, will be on Sunday, October 31 from 6:00 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. We always go along with Lorain County Community Alliance, which most of the cities belong to and we kind of pull in the general consensus and that is the date that they have picked and we've been publishing that. So, that will be the date and time for this year; once again, is Sunday, October 31 from 6:00 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. That concludes my report. Thank you.

President Corcoran: Thank you, Mayor Gillock. Mr. Safety-Service Director.

B. Safety-Service Director:

Safety-Service Director Armbruster: Mine will be relatively short, but unfortunately, Mr. Papes isn't here today. I'm talking about trucks and that we've looked into for all of us, City Council and for the Administration, looked into innovative ways in order to control the truck traffic on our non-truck roads that are out there. Unfortunately, the options that are available, when it comes to technology, one is a weight and censor system that is being established by a company called ACS, that is actually going to do this on the Ohio Turnpike as they go through the EZ Pass. Unfortunately, the cost of something like this, as it would have to be permanently installed, would be 100,000 to 200,000 dollars. The cameras can not only guestimate the speed, but also the weight of the truck. When we looked at the feasibility of using traffic cameras in any other way, it was not feasible just on the cost of doing so. So, the answer back from the Police Department is the essence of the old way that we are doing it and that is with due diligence when it comes to our Police Department that are out there and look at the signage that we have to make sure that the signage is more visible. The Administration recognizes that there are trucks. There is a lot of confusion out there just based on the number of streets where we do not allow trucks on; especially when you go out on Lorain Road where some of it you can have, some of it you can't; you can't go any further. It makes it very difficult to understand the policies of our truck-policy streets in the city of North Ridgeville. That concludes my report.

Mayor Gillock: Mr. President, we have a deadline if we are going to appeal that. We have to do it within 30 days of receipt. The Budget Commission took their action on August 17. We

actually received the documents and I don't know if they are date stamped or not, but the letter is dated August 23. So, we have just a couple of days to get this passed to meet the deadline to appeal this. If you will recall, we have been doing this every year for several years. The Ohio Revised Code sets up a statutory formula for distribution of Local Government Funds. It also allows for an alternate distribution formula of Local Government Funds and a Revenue Assistance Fund. That was done many years ago. Several years ago, the city of Lorain appealed that alternative formula and the county of Lorain settled with them, by giving them 500,000 dollars that year. They took 250,000 dollars out of their funds and 250,000 from all the cities who were participants in the distribution of Local Government Funds. So, our contention is that since they took 250,000 dollars from our funds without our vote, we had basically the same argument as Lorain had in the first case and we've been appealing this. We lost at the Tax Commissioner's level and appealed to the State Supreme Court where we were successful; who remanded it back to the Tax Commissioner. The Tax Commissioner ruled that in the first year, we won, but they didn't rule on any subsequent years. So, we would like to basically protect our interest and get this passed this evening and then the Law Director and I are going to sit down and take another look at the validity and whether it's worth continuing to fight this battle, which I think it is, but we need to periodically delve into this again to make sure we understand all the nuances and so forth that go along with it. So, if we are going to continue to issue our appeal, we do need to get this passed this evening.

We are still approved for 80 percent, but we need to go back to NOACA to basically update the numbers and if we do that, we need Council's support on that issue. We don't need the emergency clause, but we would like to get this passed this evening.

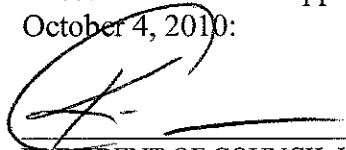

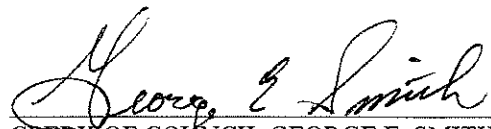
